
European Rowing clubs take action to tackle Plastic Pollution

The 2025 edition of the <u>European Rowing Coastal and</u> <u>Beach Sprint Championships</u> that will take place in *Manavgat, Türkiye from 8 to 12 October 2025* will link sport, science, and sustainability.



Citizen Science

WWF Türkiye

"Adopt a Beach"

- Rowers from European Rowing clubs, volunteers, and local communities join hands to clean and monitor plastic waste along Manavgat's coastline (Kleopatra Beach).
- Data collected contributes to WWF's regional pollution database.

Microplastic Analysis

- Rowers from European Rowing clubs and volunteers collect water samples during rowing training on the ocean.
- Akdeniz (Mediterranean) University analyses microplastics in the samples, turning athletes into citizen scientists.



Conservation Leadership

Protection of the endangered Caretta caretta (Loggerhead sea turtle) and sensitive coastal species such as the Mediterranean sand lily.

We will establish buffer zones around sea turtle nesting sites and Mediterranean sand lily habitats.

Athletes & volunteers will be engaged on biodiversity, conservation & marine plastic pollution.




